explicit instruction for reading success.

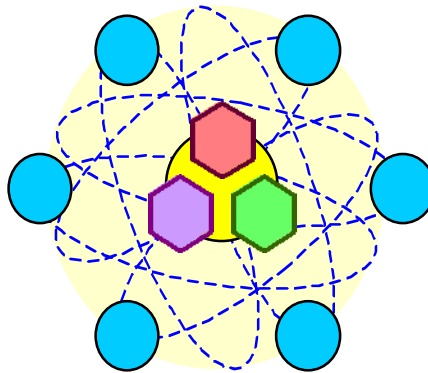

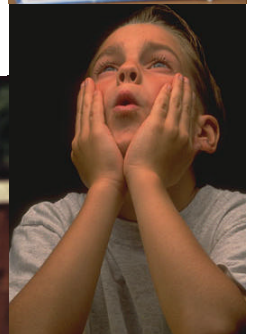


THE HAAN RESEARCH INSTITUTE:
